The watchmaking family Hiltel, also known as Hiltl, came from Regensburg. G. Ch. Hiltel (most likely Georg Christian) is recorded as watchmaker in Regensburg around 1750. Around 1800, his two sons Johann Nicolaus and Samuel Christian were also watchmakers in Regensburg.
