The watch case was manufactured in Larpernt & Jürgensen's own establishment. The punchmark "KPF/JJ" means "Kongelig Privilegeret Fabrik/Jürgen Jürgensen" (Royal Warranted Factory/Jürgen Jürgensen).

Jörgen Jürgensen (1748-1811) was the father of the renowned watchmaker Urban Juergensen; he started a watchmaking factory in Copenhagen in 1775 and went into partnership with Isaac Larpernt in 1780. From then on the company operated under the name

"Larpen & Juergensen" in Roskilde.
